

Speaker of the North West Legislature, Hon. Dantjie on Route to the Rustenburg Local Municipality for Change and Transformation

Hon. Dantjie attests that a lot has been done to resolve the battles vested towards socio-economic freedom, and a lot still needs to be done to resolve the triple challenges of unemployment, poverty and inequality.

“The establishment of local municipalities in our province, has been vested with the responsibility to ensure that the marginalised benefit and are accorded a life that can be sustainable.

“But in many instances, our institutions have seen the inner battles of leaders caused by power and greed that have affected service delivery in the province. The psychological effects of apartheid have also contributed to deteriorating development of many, in as much as the past pains, grudges and hate that have infested this nation,” said Hon. Dantjie

It was in this stance that the Speaker of the Legislature, needed to continue the programme of reconciliation, healing and renewal that was formally introduced by her former predecessor, Hon. Supra Mahumapelo who is currently the Premier of the North West province in September 2012.
