

O re bone, re go bone – Legislature Takes Parliament to Bojanala District Municipality

On 11-14 March 2019 the North West Provincial Legislature will be holding the O re bone, re go bone – Taking Parliament to the People in various municipalities under the Bojanala District Municipality. The “O re bone re go bone” which literally means *“You see us and we see you”*, is a programme aimed at taking Legislature to the people to strengthen oversight and public participation and to promote accountability and transparency in government.

During the programme, Members of the Provincial Legislature will also interact with different provincial departments and their MECs; Mayors, members of the Municipal Public Accounts Committees, ward committees, traditional authorities, farmers and their respective organisations, organised structures and members of the public on issues affecting them.
